

THE FULLERTON HOTEL SINGAPORE CELEBRATES THE YEAR OF THE PIG WITH AN AUSPICIOUS GRAND FEAST AT JADE

Chinese Executive Chef Leong Chee Yeng serves up a sumptuous bounty of delicacies to usher in the Lunar New Year in 2019



SINGAPORE, Wednesday, 5th DECEMBER 2018 – The Fullerton Hotel Singapore rings in the Year of the Pig with auspicious offerings at its signature Cantonese restaurant Jade. From 21st January to 19th February 2019, Jade’s Executive Chef Leong Chee Yeng has meticulously curated six festive menus culminating in the eight-course Grand Fullerton Golden Feast, 富丽豪华金猪宴.

Featuring top-shelf ingredients such as lobster, suckling piglet, caviar and bird’s nest and priced at an auspicious \$2,388 (for 10 persons), the Grand Fullerton Golden Feast showcases traditional Chinese New Year staples updated for a modern palate, alongside new creative culinary creations by Chef Leong.

The star of the show is the **Gold Rush Yu Sheng featuring lobster, Australian abalone and Norwegian salmon**. The picture-perfect masterpiece comes with pink radish artfully arranged to resemble a cute piglet, a painstaking operation that requires 1.5 hours. Another nod to the Year of the prosperous Pig is the **Triple Bliss Braised and Roasted Pork Belly with Steamed Bun and Crispy Suckling Piglet Skin** topped with a generous dollop of **Caviar**.

Fish or 'yu' in Mandarin is a homonym for 'surplus' and symbolises abundance on the Lunar New Year table. For the Grand Fullerton Golden Feast, guests will have a choice of two different types of fish: **Prosperity Stir-fried Sliced Red Grouper served with Head and Tail intact**, and the **Full of Luck Deep-fried Chilean Seabass with Hawthorne Sauce**. Both dishes are newly created by Chef Leong and his team for this year's Lunar New Year menu.

Other requisite Lunar New Year offerings include Chef Leong's **Poached Preserved Vegetable and Mushroom Pork Dumplings**, shaped like ingots and streaked with natural beetroot juice for an auspicious red colour; the richly flavoured **Pork Tripe Soup** brimming with wholesome revitalising goodness and **spiked with a dash of Hennessy XO Cognac** at the table; and the **Fragrant Wok-fried Glutinous Rice with Chinese Sausages** prepared with five different grains -- specifically brown rice, buckwheat, oat, barley and mushroom crispy rice.

For desserts, ring in sweet tidings with **Jade's Hot Eight Treasures Soup with "Tang Yuan" and Bird's Nest, Baked Golden Pig Pineapple Cookies** and Chef Leong's dainty **Baked Yam Paste "Nian Gao" Tart**, a modern take on the Lunar New Year classic.
