SINGAPORE, 25 September 2017 – In support of Breast Cancer Foundation’s (BCF) dedication to raise awareness and promote early detection of the illness, The Fullerton Hotel will be awash in pink with a façade illumination from 4 to 10 October 2017 between 6.45 p.m. and midnight. A Pink-themed Afternoon Tea will also be presented at The Courtyard from 1 to 31 October 2017.

The Fullerton Hotel will be one of four iconic buildings lit in pink for one week, joining National Gallery Singapore, Chijmes and Ion Orchard to shine a spotlight on this global movement.

Aligned with BCF’s month-long October campaign, The Courtyard’s Pink-themed Afternoon Tea draws inspiration from the iconic Pink Ribbon that is synonymous with the foundation’s



mission to provide and express support for women suffering from the affliction. Five specially commissioned confections crafted by the Fullerton's pastry team, will sit on top of the three-tier Afternoon Tea set. Comprising both local and international flavours, these additional sweet items mark a celebration of BCF's concerted efforts both in Singapore and around the world.

The familiar local taste of rose syrup is infused into the mousse of Rose Layer Cake, and oval-shaped Bandung Macarons. Sharing the limelight are international favourites created with a twist in Vanilla Éclair with White Chocolate Glaze, Pink Chocolate Tube with Champagne Sabayon Mousse, and Baked Almond Raspberry Cake dipped in Chocolate. Freshly baked Rosella-flavoured Scones, a quintessential afternoon tea treat, are also served warm to the table accompanied with clotted cream and berry jam.

For the savouries, pops of pink hues delight in Organic Beet-Egg Mayonnaise on a Toasted Roll, Rose-flavoured Caviar on Lobster Salad in a Purple Tartlet, and Seared Ahi Tuna Sumac with Tobiko and Bellerose in a Toasted Carrot Leaf; for an Afternoon Tea experience to be cherished with the women in your life.

The three-tiered Afternoon Tea Set is served under the sunlit atrium of The Courtyard on Monday to Friday from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m., and on Weekends and Public Holidays from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. (first seating) and 4.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. (second seating), and is priced at **S\$50*** per person, inclusive of free-flowing tea and coffee, and unlimited replenishment of tiered contents.
