Jade’s Chef de Cuisine Leong Chee Yeng has crafted a medley of gourmet plates for his 2017 reunion menus. The signature **Eight Happiness Gold Rush Yu Sheng** is served on a platter decorated with calligraphic drawings of roosters and auspicious greetings to accompany fresh slices of Salmon, house-made Champagne Jelly, and drizzles of Olive Oil and Honey Pineapple Dressing.

Delicately stuffed and hand-folded to imitate a rooster’s crown, **Poached Cockscomb-shaped Chicken Dumplings** showcases the culinary team’s dexterity and creative plating technique. In **Stewed Chicken and Crab Meat Duo with Red Wine and Chinese Wine in Claypot**, Chef Leong stages his Cantonese rendition of Surf and Turf in a safari of flavours.
