SINGLE MALT SCOTCHES

Speyside

Aberlour A'Bunadh

Meaning 'the original' in Gaelic, A'bunadh has achieved a cult following among malt lovers **\$20**

The Balvenie – Doublewood

This Speysider was initially aged in traditional oak casks before it was finished in casks which previously held Caribbean rum. Sweet vanilla forms a creamy palate with notes of apples and mangoes with a hint of orange in the background *\$17*

Cardhu 12 yr

Pioneered by Helen and Elizabeth Cumming, two of the earliest female distillers, this medium gold dram is known for its sweet aromatics and rich palate of orange, dark chocolate, delicate smoke and toffee *\$14*

Cragganmore 12 yr

This Speyside is rich and spicy, with a very satisfying complexity and well-sherried backbone *\$14*

Craigallachie 12 yr

Oodles of dynamic fruit notes with a distinctive current of smoke running through the middle *\$14*

Dalwhinnie 15 yr

Rated 95 points by Jim Murray. An underrated classic with just a hint of smoke. Lots of apple, pear and toffee *\$16*

Glenfarclas 17 yr

Full-bodied and rich, it fills and coats the palate with warming nutmeg, sherried fruits, cinnamon and mixed peels. A complex and sophisticated dram worthy of a taste! *\$22*

Glenfiddich 12 yr

The world's number one selling single malt. Glenfiddich accounts for 35% of the world's single malt scotch sales. Enough said! *\$10*

Glenfiddich IPA

First they made the beer and then aged it in barrels for a month. They then took the barrels to the distillery and aged the scotch in the same IPA barrels. A noble experiment *\$12*

Glennfiddich XX

A collaboration of 20 Malt masters to pick 20 barrels and then marry them together for one stupendous single malt \$18

Glenfiddich 18 yr

Glenfiddich 21 yr Winter Storm

Glenfiddich 21 yr Gran Reserva

Finished in Caribbean Rum soaked casks to give this well aged whisky notes of vanilla and toffee sweetness. Complex and smoky with a nose of leather and oak **\$60**

Glengrant 12 yr

Orchard fruits open it up, with orange and apple. A touch of pastry and a dusting of icing sugar. Touches of almonds last on the finish *\$14*

The Glenlivet Founders Reserve

A NAS scotch that garners excellent reviews. "Delicate and complex, this newly released Scotch boasts scents of maple sugar and spice, and unfurls on the palate with a distinctly floral start that evolves into creamy vanilla, honey, sarsaparilla and baking spice" **\$9**

The Glenlivet 12-year-old

The world's second most consumed single malt. Grassy and light with floral notes **\$10**

The Glenlivet 15-year-old

This lovely 15-year-old whisky is matured in French Limousin oak casks. The Limousin oak has a more open grain which lets the whisky get into the oak. Creamy rich and buttery on the nose with sweet fruits and delicate spice on the palate *\$16*

The Glenlivet 18-year-old

Expect lots of honey and caramel from the get-go, winding into an interestingly dry and lingering finish entwining leather, cocoa, coconut and ginger **\$28**

The Glenlivet Archive 21-year-old

The nose is full and rich with notes of sandalwood and pine with a long sweet finish. Highly regarded by the world's whisky lovers **\$55**

Macallan 12-year-old - Sherry Oak

Crisp and sweet with notes of sultanas and fresh apple blossom. One of the best out there in its age group *\$14*

Macallan 15-year-old

Sublime and full, with a hint of rose and cinnamon. The taste is intense with rich chocolate with a hint of orange and raisin. The finish is lingering with a hint of chocolate, orange and dried fruits *\$24*

Macallan 18-year-old

With maturation taking place in a combination of European Sherry seasoned casks, American Sherry seasoned casks and American ex-bourbon casks, this expression boasts bountiful notes of vanilla, dried fruit and wood spice **\$60**

Macallan - Rare Cask

Ruby red in colour. On the nose, soft notes of opulent vanilla and raisin give way to a sweet ensemble of apple, lemon, and orange. All balanced by a spicy quartet of root ginger, cinnamon, nutmeg and clove. On the palate, this spicy quartet is unwavering. Oak resonates, timeless, polished and rich. Vanilla and chocolate lead the finale along with a light citrus zest. The finish is warming and woody **\$70**

Highlands

Aberfeldy 16-year-old

This expression is finished in Oloroso Sherry casks. Raisins and cinnamon on the nose give way to butterscotch and caramel *\$20*

Ancoc 12-year-old

Whisky Distiller of the year 2017. A delicate scotch with flavours of barley, spices and butterscotch-vanilla *\$14*

Dalmore 12-year-old

Aged in Bourbon Barrels then half is transferred to Sherry barrels to finish. The two halves are blended back together for a fruit forward; sweet and rich whisky **\$16**

Dalmore - King Alexander III

A sextuple-wood bottling from Dalmore. This auspiciouslynamed dram was matured in wine, Madeira, Sherry, Marsala, Kentucky bourbon and Port casks. Medium, well-rounded. Winter berries, spice, zesty orange. Liqueurs emerge; Grand Marnier, Kirsch and Frangelico **\$55**

Deveron 12 yr

A core of butterscotch with waxy malt and apple pie. A sweet and delicious dram. Finishes with wood spice, vanilla and soft oakiness *\$10*

Glenmorangie 10-year-old - Original

The backbone of the Glenmorangie whiskys. Fruity and thick with a long malty finish *\$12*

Glenmorangie Signet

While it carries no-age-statement, there is said to be an element of some of the distillery's oldest and rarest stocks, ranging from 35 to 40 years old, in this Highland single malt. Sweet, syrupy cinnamon and drying malt lead, before a suggestion of Terry's Chocolate Orange rises. A hint of lime rind is present, as are lychees and dates. Utterly Superb! **\$40**

Oban 14-year-old

The distillery was built in 1794. The whisky takes the best of the highlands and combines it with the peaty flavours of the islands *\$22*

Oban 21 year old

Limited release. Distilled in 1996 and bottled in 2018. Cask strength at 57.9% ABV. Intense smooth sweetness of orange on the nose that carries through on the palate. It changes in the glass and you get all kinds of flavours coming through. Intriguing indeed **\$99**

Old Pulteney Cask Strength 2007

Described as the Maritime Malt, Old Pulteney is distilled in the port of Wick, Caithness. This expression was laid down in 2007 in cask number 1471. Matured for more than a decade in a single cask. No. 254 of 372 bottles **\$32**

Louelands

Auchentoshan 12-year-old

An aroma of carmelized almonds and vanilla make this the Crème Brule of scotch *\$12*

Auchentoshan Three Wood

A Lowland single malt matured in three different casks, namely; Pedro Ximenez Sherry casks, bourbon casks and Olorosso Sherry casks. Rich. Liqueur cherries in dark chocolate, more sherried fruit, ripe dark forest fruits, like Black Forest Gateaux *\$14*

Glenkinchie 12-year-old

Based close to Edinburgh. It has come to be known as the Edinburgh malt. You will pick up notes of lemon grass then a spicier lively finish *\$15*



Talisker 10-year-old (Isle of Skye)

A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peels, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed *\$16*

Isle of Jura 12-year-old

Matured in a combination of American Oak and Olorosso Sherry casks. Flavours of chocolate fudge, nutty barley and pear come through *\$15*

Highland Park 10-year-old (Orkneys)

A subtle Sherry influence but balanced with a heathery smoke and a taste of sea spray **\$10**

Highland Park 12-year-old (Orkneys)

Salted lemons and honey with a taste of crunchy green apples followed by a smoky finish with a silky mouth feel **\$12**

Highland Park 18-year-old (Orkneys)

Ripe fruit and floral notes followed by soft smoke. Complex and delicious. A constant favourite amongst whisky lovers **\$30**

Ledaig 10 yr (Isle of Mull)

Quite light and well-balanced. Medium-bodied and quite rich. There are notes of spice and smoke gathering above the charred oak. The peat is quiet and dry with a touch of black pepper and earth *\$12*

Islay

Ardbeg 10-year-old

This is a big powerful whisky filled with smoke! Citrus and pear notes squeeze their way though but the smoke lingers for hours *\$14*

Ardbeg Uigeadail

Uigeadail consists of a marriage of younger whisky (from 1990 and 1993) with much older whisky matured in sherry casks. The marriage works exceptionally well, with the younger whiskies providing the classic Ardbeg intensity many of us have come to expect, while the older whiskies contribute depth, maturity, and complexity **\$24**

Bowmore 12-year-old

The peaty smokiness of this Islay favourite is balanced with lemon and honey *\$12*

Bruichladdich Laddie

Delicate aromas of honey and dried fruit combine with flavours of caramel and apricots with a light smokiness indicative of Islays *\$12*

Lagavulin 16-year-old

Intense and smoky-sweet. Seaweed flavours with a big smoky finish. Double gold medal at the World Spirit awards 2017 **\$24**

Laphroaig 10-year-old

Very peaty with hints of honey and black pepper. A touch of water adds to the nuances of this whisky **\$14**

Bunnahabhain

The taste starts with a light fruit and nut appeal that leads to a malty sweetness, finishing into a beautifully rich full-bodied experience *\$16*





INTERNATIONAL SINGLE MALTS

Paul John Bold (India)

Peat is brought over to Goa from Islay for Bold, where it is used to dry their 6-row Indian barley. Honeyed oak and fruity coffee with that Islay peat again making its character gently known, spicy porridge, lime and dry toast *\$22*

Puni Sole (Italy)

The taste is distinctively sweet with strong notes of honey and blood orange that are counterpointed by creamy flavours of walnut and spicy oak *\$20*

Amrut Fusion (India)

A blend of Indian and Scottish elements. Combines fruit, oak and vanilla with a touch of peat **\$17**

Laird of Fintry (Canada)

A small batch Canadian single malt. With forest notes of toasted oak and tones of vanilla, plum and raisins **\$13**

Laird of Fintry Rum Cask

The original Laird of Fintry finished in a rum cask which adds a lovely sweetness **\$14**

A blend of 50 Canadian whiskies. This whisky was placed on the train to commemorate the visit of King George VI in 1939 wrapped in its iconic purple bag. Crown is rich and robust with hints of vanilla and oak *\$8*

Crown Royal Northern Harvest Rye

This whisky made headlines in 2016 when it won World Whisky of the Year in Jim Murrays Whisky Bible! A touch spicier with a higher rye content but still Crown Royal smooth **\$9**

Bearface

A relative new comer to the Canadian Whisky world. Bearface is aged 7 years in Bourbon barrels and then put into Red Wine barrels and finally finished in new Hungarian oak barrels **\$8**

Bearface One Eleven

Ten parts whisky and one part mezcal! They have taken Bearface and have added Oaxan mezcal to give it a delightful smoky finish *\$9*

Gibson's 12 year old

Gibson's believes that character is only revealed with time;12 years has resulted in this exceptional whisky. Rich with smooth and balanced flavours of caramel and spicy notes on a lengthy finish **\$7**

Gooderham & Worts

A blend of corn, rye, wheat and barley and bottled at 44.4% ABV this pours a golden/amber colour. The four garains all add their unique flavours to give this whisky wonderful notes of honey, toffee and stone fruit **\$7**

Okanagan Spirits Rye

With a blend of 51% of our Coldstream Valley Rye, and 49% of our locally malted BC Barley, this three year-old hand-crafted Rye is aged in our custom American white oak barrels and then cut with our secret source of local artesian well water *\$10*

Lot 40 Rye

Expertly distilled in small batches using only the finest locally sourced ingredients. By distilling in a single copper pot still, the result is a whisky that starts off earthy and woody tasting and then becomes full bodied and complex with a velvety vanilla oak finish *\$8*

Okanagan Spirits BRBN

A unique Canadian version of Bourbon. But they can't call it bourbon as it is made here in the Okanagan and not in the US. However, they do follow the bourbon-making rules and craft a fine Canadian substitute *\$10*

Okanagan Spirits Laird of Fintry

Distilled in a copper pot still and using only malted barley, yeast and water the folks up in Vernon have crafted a fine single malt. Highly coveted and sold by lottery do not miss the chance to taste this fine whisky **\$13**

Laird of Fintry Rum Cask

Our local distillers have also recently produced a rum cask expression of the Laird of Fintry that we also carry with pride \$14

Pike Creek

Stored in non-climate controlled warehouse Pike Creek barrels expand in the summer and contract in the winter driving the whisky into the wood giving the liquid a rich amber colour. Peppery notes and toffee on the nose give way to dried fruits on the palate **\$7**

BOURBON/AMERICAN

Wild Turkey

This Kentucky Bourbon is aged up to six to eight years in "alligator charred" barrels, yielding honey-vanilla aromatics and mouthwatering, rounded maple and vanilla notes that close out with clove and cinnamon spark *\$*7

Col. E.H. Taylor

Sweet on the attack, but with a real muscular profile. Ginger snaps, milk chocolate, candied apple, and pecan brittle percolate through an energetic whisky that demands attention. The finish is dry, long, and complex *\$17*

Jim Beam

Aged four years in new American Oak barrels. A long family tradition has created one of the world's most popular bourbons. Sweet corn, caramel smoothness has a loyal following all around the world **\$7**

Four Roses

Crisp yet soft and smooth. Fresh fruit, hints of pear and apple with a mellow, long and pleasant finish. Multiple Gold medal award winner **\$8**

Old Forester

A soft and sweet aroma with a taste that softens quickly with hints of sweet cron and oak. Spicy with soft vanilla and light orange notes. Created in 1870 it is the only whisky to maintain production before, during and after prohibition **\$7**

Eagle Rare

Aged for no less than 10 years. The nose is complex, with aromas of toffee, hints of orange peel, herbs, honey, leather and oak. Tastes of candied almonds and rich cocoa finish dry and lingering **\$11**

Blanton's Single Barrel

The Kentucky Derby bourbon. The first single barrel bourbon sold commercially. A deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg and spices. Powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with hints of honey amid strong caramel and corn *\$18*

Buffalo Trace

This deep amber whiskey has a complex aroma of vanilla, mint and molasses. Pleasantly sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise \$8

BOURBON/AMERICAN

Makers Mark

Red winter wheat is used to add to the corn to give this bourbon a very smooth taste. Woody oak, caramel, vanilla and wheat prevail on the nose with a balance of caramel, vanilla and fruity essences. The finish is smooth and subtle **\$9**

Legent

This is a very unique bourbon as it is a collaboration of two famous whiskey makers. Fred Noe, Jim Beam's Master distiller and Shinji Fukuyo, Suntory's chief blender. The bourbon is aged for 5 years then finished in California wine casks and a second finish in Sherry casks \$8

Knob Creek

Rich, sweet, woody, full bodied, almost fruity. An unflinching balance of deep, old-style flavor with natural oak sweetness \$8

Longbranch

A bourbon with Texan connections. The liquid goes through two filtrations. One of American white oak and another through Texas Mesquite wood. A collaboration with Mathew McConaughey and Wild Turkey Master distiller Edie Russell *\$10*

Woodford Reserve

A clean brilliant honey amber colour. Rich, chewy, rounded and smooth, with complex fruits, cinnamon and cocoa. Toffee, caramel, chocolate and spice notes abound. Multiple gold medal winner. The distillery dates from 1812 and is a National Historic site *\$8*

Woodford Reserve Double oaked

Uniquely matured in separate, charred oak barrels – the second barrel deeply toasted before a light charring – extracts additional amounts of soft, sweet oak character *\$12*

Bookers

This bourbon is not for the weak. A very complex and intense nose that runs from oak, leather, caramel and hints of fruits continues o the tongue with a very pleasant burn that gives way to more leather, oak vanilla and spice. It's a bourbon with a bite and should be bloomed with some water *\$15*

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Basil Hayden's

With aromas of spice, tea and a hint of peppermint, Basil Hayden's has a very pleasant light-bodied and gentle bite with a clean dry finish. A high amount of Rye grain in the mash bill lends a nice spiciness **\$9**

Basil Hayden Dark Rye

With aromas of spice, tea and a hint of peppermint, Basil Hayden's has a very pleasant light-bodied and gentle bite with a clean dry finish. A high amount of Rye grain in the mash bill lends a nice spiciness **\$10**

Weller

The original wheated bourbon whiskey features an exceptionally smooth taste by substituting wheat for rye grain. This bourbon stands out with its burnt orange colour and softer flavor notes by avoiding the spiciness of the rye grain *\$8*

1792 (Bottled in Bond)

This straight Kentucky bourbon whiskey is "from barrels all filled during the same season was bottled at exactly 100 proof." The color of a rich wildflower honey. It thinly coats and clings to the glass. Warm and full, and more mouth-forward. The aromas are brought through in the flavour, with a layered maple and coffee-toffee sweetness and oak grounded by an earthy quality. The finish lingers, with a smooth yet spicy and savory buzz *\$12*

Jefferson's

Made from 4 bourbon blend. Nose is rather light with vanilla, yeast and farm notes. Palate is smooth wit a nice, slightly oily mouthfeel. Notes of buttered and peppered corn and caramel come across. Finishes with honey and oak *\$10*

Jefferson's Ocean

This was an experiment by the owner of Jefferson's. He put three barrels in the hold of a ship for three years. The result was that more whisky came in contact with the barrel bringing out the caramel from the wood. The sea air impacted the flavor as well bringing a brininess to the liquid. It has been a huge success for Jefferson's. Now a barrel of Jefferson's Ocean will cross the equator at least four times and have over thirty ports of call! *\$18*

BOURBON/AMERICAN

Rittenhouse Rye

Rittenhouse Straight Rye Whiskey has a storied past with a heritage that commemorates Philadelphia's famous Rittenhouse Square. Bottled-in-Bond, today's Rittenhouse carries the distinct, spicy flavor that is long associated with the brand *\$12*

Sazerac Rye

Versatile, crisp, and an ideal match for cocktails that also include orange liqueur as well as its namesake classic cocktail. Light aromas include vanilla and a touch of juicy citrus. Flavours run to bitter chocolate, and black tea, finishing with a peppery tingle. Velvety fee, despite the brisk alcohol *\$10*

Jack Daniels Honey

A blend of Jack Daniels whiskey and a unique honey liqueur of their own making. With hints of honey and a finish that is naturally smooth \$8

Jack Daniels

Mellowed through 10 feet of sugar maple charcoal. It is only ready when their tasters say it is. Look, aroma and taste are all factors **\$8**

Heaven's Door

Heaven's Door is a whiskey brand developed in collaboration with Bob Dylan. The bottles feature the iron gates created by Dylan in his studio. Elegantly perfumed with notes of toasted wheat, cereal, tree dust and marzipan. The palate is elevated and airy almost weightless *\$17*

Michters Sour Mash

Whisky Exchange Whisky of the year for 2019. First whiskey made in the United States to achieve this honour. Its unique grain selection means it cannot be categorized as a rye or a bourbon. Its name comes from using some of the fermented mash from the previous batch as a starter for the new mash to be fermented *\$15*

Virginia Black

A collaboration between Brent Hocking (Deleon Tequila) and Drake. Yes, that Drake. A blend of 2, 3, and 4-year-old bourbons. Smooth and silky with notes of caramel and some spiciness from rye grains **\$9** IRISH WHISKEY



Jameson

A blend of pot still and grain whiskey. Then triple distilled to give the whiskey its signature smoothness. Then aged in oak casks for four years. The largest selling Irish whiskey in the world producing 31,000,000 bottles annually! **\$7**

Bushmills

The whiskey from the North. Widely considered the oldest distillery in the world being granted a charter to produce whiskey in 1608 by King James I *\$*7

Tullamore DEW

Second only to Jameson in worldwide sales. The DEW on the label is the initials of Tullamore's former owner Daniel E. Williams who worked himself up from stable boy to the owner **\$7**

Redbreast 12 yr

This is a pot stilled whisky (single malt) which is triple distilled from malted and unmalted barley. Matured in Bourbon and then Oloroso Sherry casks. Spicy and fruity *\$13*

Writers Tears

Only begun in 1999 this whiskey has entered the market as a superpremium, triple distilled craft Irish Whiskey **\$11**

Tyrconnell 15 yr

This Madeira finished Irish gem is double distilled like a single malt then aged in Bourbon barrels for 15 years. After that it is finished in Madeira wine casks **\$20**

Glendalough

A tiny craft distillery from the Wicklow mountains has a Kelowna connection. One of our own is a stakeholder in the distillery! Our own taste of Ireland *\$8*

Teeling Small Batch

Started in hand-picked oak casks and finished in rum barrels this is a very smooth Irish. This has been a family run distillery since 1782 **\$12**

Green Spot Chateau Montelena

Matured initially in Bourbon and Sherry Barrels then finished in casks from the famed Chateau Montelena. Traditional fresh peeled green apple, honey, and cut meadow grasses are all present in this beloved Irish whiskey **\$18** Margherita

Bocconcini cheese, crushed tomato sauce, oregano and fresh basil **\$13.25**

G Salmon Crab Cake

2 pcs of wild BC salmon and rock crab cakes, with a siracha aioli and winter greens **\$12.95**

🕒 Chili Chicken

Served on crispy wonton shells green onions, and toasted sesame seeds *\$11.95*

G* Grilled Cheese

House made sourdough bread, with havarti and brie cheeses, apricot confit *\$13.95*
